History of Goodhue Congregation (1888-1973)

The events of the present are always colored by the heritage that preceded them. This is also true of the Goodhue congregation.

Many of the pioneers who settled in this community were of Scandinavian descent and the Lutheran faith.

Quite a number of these people came from Goodhue County, MN and some from Decorah, IA. In their former homes, they had the privilege of having a place for worship. Here there was none. Feeling the need for a Church home, plans were made for such an edifice. Hardships abounded on the wide open prairies, but the pioneers had a knowledge of, and a faith in God, knowing the Lord would guide them, and give them strength and courage to carry on.


On Sunday, September 16, 1888, there gathered in the granary of the Asaph Chilson

homestead, located one-half mile North of the present church, a small but determined group of families for the purpose of organizing a Norwegian Lutheran Church. Under the direction of Rev. L.E. Kjelaas, a pastor of the Webster vicinity, a Charter was drawn up. The Charter members being: Amund Chilson, Andrew Soreng, Lars Stran, Carl Ronning, John Soreng, Jens Williamson, Martin Soreng, Thomas Jesme, Lars Olson, and Soren Hjermstad with their families.

Other families who soon joined the congregation were: John Westby, Sam Williamson, Nils Holtan, Olai Skajem, Asaph Chilson, Andrew Larson, Peter Bergh, Paul Fjelstad, Christian



Goodhue Lutheran Church, seven miles northwest of Florence. The congregation was organized in 1888. Seventy-five percent of the charter members came from Goodhue County Minnesota, its namesake.

Larson, Nils Meland, Herman Meland, John Hjelmeland, Peter Kirkeby, Lars Ohnstad, Halvor Lovald, George Skajem and Peter Skajem.

Of these early pioneers, all have passed to their eternal rest. However, some of their children and grandchildren are in our midst, active and giving of their lives to the keeping of the Church. To these direct descendants, we dedicate this history.

At the organizational meeting it was decided to give the new Congregation the name "Goodhue" in reference to the large percentage recently come from Goodhue County, MN. The first officers were: Jens Williamson, Percenter; Carl Ronning, Treasurer; Lars Olson and Thomas Jesme, Trustees; Andrew Soreng and Amund Chilson, Deacons; and Martin Soreng, Secretary.

Three acres of land was purchased from John Westby in 1889 for \$20.00 per acre. This was to be used for Cemetery grounds. This is also the present Church and cemetery setting.

Rev. Kjelaas served the congregation from 1888 to 1893 with a salary of \$50.00 per year. He lived near Grenville, SD and for every service had to drive a round trip of between fifty and sixty miles with a team of horses. We find he conducted about sixty services in the congregation during the given years he served. Parochial school was started under Rev. Kjelaas in 1891.

On July 23, 1893, Rev. Sjur Rislov preached his first sermon in the congregation and also served St. Pauli and Helgen for a period of eight years. His farewell Service being October 27, 1901. Rev. Rislov lived in a small house owned by Christian Larson just across the road East of where Julian Johnsons now live.

From October 1901 until 1902 the congregation was served by Rev. Flakoll of Bristol, SD and by other visitation pastors and seminary students.

Rev. John Madsen was called and began his duties as pastor on June 29, 1902. He served nine years. In 1902 a parsonage was built by the three congregations which at that time comprised a parish, namely, St. Pauli, Helgen, and Goodhue. Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Meland now own and live in that parsonage just South of the church.

In 1904 the present Church edifice was erected. Until that time, services had been conducted in the Meland school house. The Church was dedicated July 5, 1909 by Rev. Dahl.

Rev. L.J. Odland served as temporary pastor from October 1911 until June 1912 when Rev. J.J.Haanstad was installed. Rev. Haanstad guided the congregation throughout the years, including the trying winter of 1918-1919, when he laid to rest six members of the congregation in less than two months, a result of the "flu" epidemic. On March 23, 1923, God called our beloved pastor to his eternal rest.

The Rev. J.E.Jorgenson served the parish temporarily after Rev. Haanstad's death until Candidate of Theology, John O. Vold, was ordained July 13, 1924 in the Goodhue Church. He served until March, 1930. It was during Rev. Vold's pastorate that the Luther League was organized and remained quite active until the merger into the A.L.C. when a group called "Hi-League" took over. The Sunday School was also organized during his pastorate.

Rev. Jorgenson again served for a few months before Rev. C.K.Malmin conducted his first service on August 31, 1930. He served the Congregation until January 1937 when he moved to Raymond, WA. During Rev. Malmin's first year here, the old parsonage was sold and the Melvin Dahle home in Florence was purchased by the Florence Parish

for the new parsonage. During his tenure, the Constitution was re-written in the English language. A new schedule was adopted calling for three English services to one Norwegian service. An L.D.R. Club for girls was also organized by Mrs. Malmin. It had Mildred Olson as its first president. This club continued until the merger when it was discontinued.

Rev. L.J. Odland served temporarily from January 1937 to September 1937, on the latter date confirming a class of seven boys and four girls. Rev. A.H.Holm of Calgary, Alberta, Canada, was called as pastor and installed by Dr. L.A.Pierson on October 24, 1937. He served the congregation and parish for over four years. During his pastorate he organized a Sunday School for the Lutherans living South of Florence. This group met each Sunday at the parsonage for their sessions. This was done because there was no Lutheran Church of the Florence parish near enough so these children could attend regularly. Rev. Holm conducted his farewell service in the Goodhue Church on January, 25, 1942 and the following day he and his family moved to their new charge at Arlington, SD.

During Rev. Holm's pastorate the Norwegian language usage was discontinued in our services. We also observed our Golden Jubilee with appropriate services in June, 1938; Rev. C.M. Weswig was guest speaker and former pastors J.E.Jorgenson, J.O Vold, C.K. Malmin and L.J. Odland were present.

Rev. C. O. Hofstad served as interim pastor for six months until Rev. H.M. Engh of Conrad, MT was installed in August 1943. The installation services were conducted by Dr. L.A.Pierson in the Goodhue Church.

On June 13, 1943, Candidate of Theology, Engvold Haanstad, was ordained in Goodhue Church with Dr. Pierson officiating. This service was one of the highlights of our church as it was the first son of our congregation to enter the ministry.

On June 17, 1944, a tornado descended on the town of Florence destroying, among other things, our parsonage and fatally injuring the mother of Mrs. Engh, Mrs. Larson. In the same storm, Mrs. Engh and her small daughter, Dorothy, were also injured. Two days following the tragic storm, the parish had purchased the M.F. Heintz home for a parsonage and the pastor's needs were being cared for.

Under the leadership of Rev. Engh, a Lutheran Brotherhood of our congregation, with St. Pauli, was organized in 1945. This continued for several years. Ultimately the name was changed to Men's Club and now contains members of the Wallace, St. Pauli, Waubay and Florence parishes, plus some from the Methodist, Baptist parish of Florence.

The Florence parish was grief stricken when they heard of the untimely passing of Mrs. J.O.Vold. Pastor Vold passed away some time later. They are both laid to rest in the Goodhue cemetery.

During Pastor Engh's pastorate the Church was wired for electricity, he doing the wiring. At this time, with the financial assistance of the W.M.F., our present church parlors was built.

At a special meeting in 1947, Nels Johnson and O.M. Olson were elected as a Committee to select a cornerstone to be set in the basement concrete. The marker bears the inscription "Goodhue Lutheran Church." Also the date 1904, when the church was built, and 1947, when the basement was completed. It was used for the first time October 5, 1947; the occasion being the reception following the marriage of Marguerite Jordeth

and Leslie McClung. The basement was officially dedicated at our Sixtieth Anniversary service, June 27, 1948.

Rev. Engh accepted a call to Fertile, MN and resigned in October 1952. Seminary students served this parish during the vacancy. In July, 1953 Pastor K. Stangeland accepted the call and was installed in the Florence parish. The Stangelands were here until June, 1957.

In 1954 our congregation adopted the pledge system favoring this system as being more in keeping with Christian Stewardship than apportionment. At this time our Sunday School time schedule was changed to run with the school year, with vacation in the summer. A Parish Board of Education was also started during Pastor Stangeland's tenure. Their responsibility was to call Sunday School teachers and Superintendent, coordinate a course of study, and aid in the instruction of the young.

In February 1957, Pastor Stangeland tendered his resignation having accepted a call to Chicago, IL.

A call then went out to Pastor Chris Christianson from Red Wing, MN. He accepted and was installed in July following his ordination. In the spring of 1958, with the financial aid of the Women's organization, and labor donated by the men, our sanctuary was redecorated. A carpenter was hired to supervise the job and when it was completed, he gave two white crosses hanging on the walls of the church auditorium.

New hymn books were purchased in 1959 after our congregation voted to join the new A.L.C. Our congregation also voted to adopt a new constitution in keeping with the joining the A.L.C.

In June of 1960, Gene Sikkink, son of Mr. and Mrs. Virgil Sikkink, was ordained in our church. This was the second son of our congregation to answer the call and we are justly proud to have had him call Goodhue his church home. Pastor Sikkink was ordained by Dr. E.O. Gilbertson, our District President.

In May 1960, Pastor Christianson resigned and moved to Ephrata, WA. The call went out and Pastor Alvin Brucklacher from Ross, ND accepted. He was installed at St. Pauli in October 1960 and had his farewell sermon June 4, 1967.

On June 24, 1962, a commissioning service was held in the Goodhue Church for Mr. and Mrs. Norris Meland, both members of our parish, who went to New Guinea and served as Missionaries there for a period of nine years. We are thankful that God saw fit to expand his kingdom through their labors in this endeavor. Upon their return to the States, they brought back and are sponsoring a native New Guinean girl, namely, Dongau Song, for a year's study in the Florence High School, and to introduce her to American culture and customs. We God's richest blessings upon Dongau and that she may be a great witness for Jesus Christ as she returns to her native land.

During Pastor Brucklacher's pastorate, a major re-alignment took place in our parish. As a result, St. Pauli severed its membership with the Florence parish and became affiliated with the Wallace parish.

Pastor Brucklacher tendered his resignation and accepted a call to Philip, SD. Then followed another period when our parish was served by seminary students, and laymen until Dennis Orsen accepted our call in 1967.

Pastor Orsen was ordained at Minneota, MN October 1 and installed in Goodhue October 15 by Dr. E.O. Gilbertson. After two years in our parish, Pastor Orsen accepted another call and we employed retired pastor Clarence Johnson of Holmquist, SD and

seminary students. Our plea went out again for another shepherd to lead our flock. This time, our present pastor, the Reverend David Hyland, responded. Rev. Hyland was ordained on June 28, 1970 at Forest City, IA and installed by Dr. E.O. Gilbertson on July 26th.

During the eighty-five years our congregation has been in existence, sixteen pastors have faithfully served our needs; six of whom are still in our midst, namely: Pastor Engh, now of Sioux Falls, SD; Pastor Stangeland of Chicago, IL; Pastor Christianson of Ephrata, WA; Pastor Brucklacher of Philip, SD; Pastor Orsen of Boston, MA; and Pastor Hyland of Florence, SD.

We are mindful of the many blessings God has bestowed upon us and the Christian heritage handed down by our pioneer forbears. May we always revere their memory. And we are especially thankful to God for the services of all the pastors and their wives who have given so much of themselves to keep ever before us, Jesus Christ and His salvation for us. To all of you, we say, "Thank you and God bless you."

Our Ladies' Auxiliary was organized in 1887. This organization has always worked hard and contributed generously to the Congregational needs and to Mission endeavors. They purchased the bell for the church during J.J. Haanstad's pastorate and it was rung for the first time the evening of the wedding of Olga Larson and Nels Johnson.

They also contributed and spurred the planning and building of the church parlors. Actual construction started on June 11, 1947. A carpenter was hired to assist with the building of the forms and additions to the main church; otherwise the work was done by free-will help. The work progressed well until harvest time when it was discontinued until after the busy season. The church parlors were first used for the wedding reception of Marguerite Jordeth and Leslie McClung on October 9, 1947.

Through a birthday offering, the ladies have been able to keep up the cemetery fence and pay for a new sidewalk in front of the Church. In 1958, the women paid for the material to seal the inside of the church. It had formerly been wainscoting. The men did the work, also the altar was painted at that time. This added much to the beauty of our house of worship.

In 1960 a son of the congregation, Gene Sikkink, was ordained into the ministry and shortly thereafter his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Virgil Sikkink, gave money for the new white paraments. The ladies then decided to give a purple one. Other items were given as memorials, etc.; green paraments, black shroud, Communion service, venetian blinds, yard light, & silver services for the church parlors.

Throughout the years the annual lutefisk supper was attended by many people in our midst, but, was discontinued several years ago and a Love" offering given instead.

In 1952 the W.M.F. inaugurated an Easter breakfast after early services.

For many years we also served an open house on 25th, 40th, and 50th wedding anniversaries if the family so wishes.

In the summer of 1962, because of heavy rainfall, our basement was severely damaged. The women again offered financial aid; the men doing the work, and the basement was entirely renovated by paint, new ceiling and new drapes. By the installation of a sump pump and dehumidifier, we hope the moisture will no longer create a problem.

In 1967 it was decided to purchase a new organ. Again the ladies accepted the challenge and through individual contributions and generous memorials by many families, the financial end was cared for.

The Sunday School was first organized by Rev. J.O. Vold in 1924. It has been discontinued and the children that were of Sunday School age have joined the New Helgen group.

For many years Goodhue has had a good musical program. Living up to the church's love of singing, we, for a number of years, maintained an active Senior Choir. They participated in both the fiftieth and sixtieth anniversaries.

Organists included Mrs. Einar Jordeth, Hilda Lovald, Mrs. O.M. Olson, Mrs. Arthur Haugen, Mary Bergan Jenkins and Gloria Haugen York.

While we were affiliated with St. Pauli, Miss Stella Ihlen served as our organist.

Since the re-alignment, Mrs. Orville Anderson and James Chilson have served as our organists.

A carpenter was hired to supervise the job of renovation and when it was completed, he gave two white crosses hanging on the walls of the church sanctuary.

The current congregation continues today with services on the third Sunday of June, July & August as well as the Easter Sunrise and special Memorial Day services. The membership consists of several 5th & 6th generation members of the original founding families and many others.
