

Downloading eBooks through Amazon

What should I do first?

- Log in to *South Dakota Titles To Go* through the Watertown Regional Library's website: <http://watlib.org>
 - Enter your library card number (no spaces) and your password (your last name).
 - You should also be prepared to log into your Amazon.com account using your login and password.

How do I find the book I want?

- Overdrive provides four collections which are available on the homepage: newly released titles, most popular titles, recommended titles, and recently returned titles.
- The collections cannot be sorted by type so it will list both eBooks and audio books in all formats.
- The menu on the left will allow you to search by genre.
- A basic search bar is available on the left above the menu.
- Once the results are displayed you may choose to view the entire collection, just the books available now, or recommend additional titles for purchase.

How do I check out a book?

- If the book you want to download says "Kindle Devices Via USB only" in red under the format information, put your Kindle into the computer before starting to download.
- Click on the "Borrow" button.
- From the download button, choose Kindle Book and then click on Confirm & Download.
- After Amazon's website opens, click on the "Get library book" button and log in to your Amazon account.
- Select the Kindle device or app you want to read the ebook on, and click "Continue".

Downloading eBooks through Amazon

How do I return books?

- You can return your books by logging into your Amazon.com account and going to the Manage Your Content and Devices.
- Click on the button that has three dots in a square across from the title you wish to return.
- Select "Return this book".

Can I place a hold on items that are checked out?

- Books can only be checked out by one person at a time. If the book is checked out, you may place a hold on it.
- If you go to the list of your holds in your account, you can see where you are on the hold list. It will not tell you when the book is due back.
- You will receive an email when your hold is available to be checked out.
- If you did not choose to automatically borrow the title, you have three days before the hold expires.

What else should I know?

- You may also search for eBooks through our online catalog.
- eBooks will only remain in your cart for 30 minutes (even if you have a hold on the book.)
- "Account" information provides access to the following:
 - Titles that are waiting in your cart and lending periods for available titles
 - Current checkouts, holds, and titles on your wish list
 - Titles that you have rated
