

## WELCOME

Welcome to Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park and Campground. Our hope is your stay here at the campground and the City of Watertown is enjoyable whether it's one day or several. We are proud of our park and city and happy to have you as our guest. The following is a guide to help answer questions and to enjoy our campground and amenities. ## STOKES THOMAS LAKE CITY PARK & CAMPGROUND FEATURES DAILY

- Camp host on-site
- 70 modern campsites with picnic tables, fire rings, water and 50 – 30 – 15 amp electric
- 4 Camping cabins with picnic tables, fire rings, water hook-up, heat, air conditioning & patio. No Pets.
- Pull-through sites with full hook-ups (sewer, water, 50 – 30 – 15 amp electric)
- TU, dorm fridges, freezer, microwave
- On-site dump station
- Modern comfort stations
- 2 playground areas
- Large picnic area with shelters
- City of Watertown recreational (bike/jogging) trail
- Boat launching facilities and park
- Campground courtesy dock
- Non-supervised swimming and large beach area
- Tornado shelter
- Watertown Veterans Memorial

## RESERVATIONS

- Make reservations online at [www.watertownparkandrec.com](http://www.watertownparkandrec.com) anytime from March 1 – September 30.
- Phone in reservations can be made by calling (605) 882-6264. A non-refundable administrative fee will apply to all phone reservations.
- All reservations will be paid in full at the time of reservation, and a non-refundable booking fee will apply.
- No reservations will be accepted from October 1 – February 28.
- Minimum of two days on weekends and three days on holiday weekends.
- A campsite can only be occupied for 14 consecutive nights before the camping unit must leave the park for at least one night.
- All campers are required to register before they set up on site.
- Campers with confirmed reservations: upon arrival, set up on your designated site and (check in) online.
- Campers without reservations: Make a reservation online, set up on designated campsite with confirmed reservation, (check in) online.
- Watertown Park, Recreation & Forestry reserves the right to refuse camping privileges to anyone.**

## TERMS OF SERVICE

- By registering to stay at Stokes-Thomas Lake City Park and Campground, you and your guests are hereby agreeing to abide by all rules and regulations.
- Deposit - 100% when booking the reservation.
- Check In/Out - Check in 2 pm, Check out 12 pm
- Quiet Hours - 11 pm – 7 am STRICTLY ENFORCED.
- 11 pm – Campground and park closed. All campers should return to their campsite and daily visitors (non-registered campers) are required to leave.
- Fireworks – No fireworks of any kind are allowed in the park or campground.
- Recreational Vehicles – No recreational vehicles (ATV, Golf Cart, Side by Side etc.)
- Speed Limit – 5 MPH

## CAMPSITE GUIDELINES

- No one camping under the AGE of 21 unless with parent. All children must be supervised at all times.
- Only (1) camping unit per site.
- 2 vehicle limit per campsite.
- 10 people per campsite.
- No washing of vehicles or camping units.
- Keep entire campsite clean and free of pet waste.
- Take all trash to dumpsters. Household trash only.

## PARKING POLICY

- Please keep roadways clear.
- Park all watercraft, trailer in adjacent parking lot.
- Park all over-flow vehicles in adjacent parking lot.
- All guests/visitors may use adjacent parking lot.
- No parking on empty campsites or on grass.
- All camping units must be backed into standard campsites.

## PET FRIENDLY POLICY

- All pets must and will be on a leash.
- All pet litter must be cleaned up immediately.
- Do not leave pets unattended at any time.

## FIRE PIT POLICY

- No BURNING of pallets, construction material, or other material containing staples or nails.
- Do not move fire rings. Keep fire contained in the fire ring.
- Do not leave campfire unattended, and all fires must be extinguished nightly and when departing campground.

## COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY POLICY

- No person or entity shall engage in the act of “peddling” or act as a “transient merchant” without park board approval.
